Participation in yearly community events is optional. This is NOT a beauty pageant.

REQUIREMENTS AND RULES

1. Contestant must like people and have a great smile.
2. Contestant must be a female and a Butler County resident.
3. **She must be 8 and not older than 10 by January 1, 2023.**
4. Each contestant must have parent/guardian consent and a parent willing to chaperone her during her reign.
5. The contestant must complete a poster (14 x 22 inches = 1/2 a poster board) depicting the theme "What I Like Best about the Butler Farm Show." Parents may advise ONLY, but not help create in any other way.
6. The contestant will "show and tell" her poster on stage and will participate in an on-stage interview.
7. **A Little Miss 4-H (must be enrolled in 4-H with a current project) AND a Little Miss who is not required to be a member of 4-H (but may be) will be selected.**
8. **All contestants must participate in a mandatory dress rehearsal the day before the contest (7 PM, Friday, August 4). POSTERS are due at this rehearsal.**
